

Quasi-Table cases


Other cases likely to settle

#### SPU PROCESS

- All new petitions reviewed by Chief Special Master
- Cases meeting criteria assigned to Chief Special Master's docket
- Other cases assigned on the wheel
- Staff attorney case management (now 6 staff attorneys)
- Chief Special Master supervision

#### TYPES OF CASES IN SPU




- Shoulder Injury Related to Vaccine Administration (SIRVA)
- Guillain-Barre Syndrome (GBS)
- BRACHIAL NEURITIS
- INTUSSUSCEPTION
- NOT A COVERED VACCINE

#### SPU Awards by Injury Type

Among cases compensated as of March 31, 2016



#### SPU OUTCOMES

Among 761 total SPU cases, 299 have resolved, with 172 cases resolved in less than 240 days.

#### SPU OUTCOMES

- Of the 299 cases resolved
  - 282 compensated (94%)
  - 17 dismissed (6%)

• 13 cases transferred to another special master (less than 2% of cases assigned to SPU)
