## **ORDER**

On February 13, 2015, the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board issued an order revoking Joseph W. Rasnic's license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia, effective on that same date. On March 18, 2015, the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit issued an Order disbarring Mr. Rasnic from practice before its court, effective on that same date. Pursuant to Rule 83.2(g)(6) of the Rules of the United States Court of Federal Claims (RCFC), an Order to Show Cause was issued by this court on June 12, 2015, and again on August 14, 2015, directing Mr. Rasnic to show cause within thirty (30) days why the imposition of identical reciprocal discipline would be unwarranted based on RCFC 83.2(c)(2) and (c)(4). As of this date, Mr. Rasnic has failed to respond to the Order to Show Cause. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Joseph W. Rasnic is suspended indefinitely from practice before the United States Court of Federal Claims pursuant to RCFC 83.2(h)(4), effective on the date this Order is entered. See RCFC 83.2(h)(4). Reinstatement is not automatic. Petitions for reinstatement are governed by RCFC 83.2(k) and must be accompanied by a certificate of good standing from the bar of the highest court of a U.S. state or the District of Columbia. See RCFC 83.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall serve Joseph W. Rasnic with a copy of this order.
