ORDER

On September 7, 2018, the Supreme Court of Nevada suspended Karen H. Ross from the practice of law in Nevada for three years, with all but the first six months stayed. *See In re Ross*, No. 74509 (Nev. Sup. Ct. Sept. 7, 2018). On January 10, 2019, this Court reciprocally suspended Ms. Ross for a period of six months effective, *nunc pro tunc*, September 7, 2018, the date of her suspension in Nevada.


Ms. Ross has submitted to the Court a Petition for Reinstatement that meets the requirements of RCFC 83.2(k), demonstrating that she is fit to resume the practice of law. On March 8, 2019, Ms. Ross was reinstated as an active member in good standing of the Bar of the State of Nevada. Based on the foregoing and for good cause shown, we conclude that it is in the interest of justice to reinstate Ms. Ross and to grant her Petition. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Karen H. Ross is reinstated to the practice of law before this Court pursuant to RCFC 83.2(k)(3). Reinstatement is effective on the date of entry of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall serve Karen H. Ross with a copy of this Order.
