ORDER


On January 27, 2015, the Court of Appeals of Maryland issued an opinion indefinitely suspending Mr. Olszewski from the practice of law in the State of Maryland with the right to apply for reinstatement after a period of six months, effective on that same date. Mr. Olszewski additionally failed to notify the court of his discipline in Maryland as required by RCFC 83.2(e)(1)(B). Pursuant to the Rules of the United States Court of Federal Claims (RCFC), an Order to Show Cause was issued by this court on June 12, 2015, directing Mr. Olszewski to show cause within thirty (30) days why the imposition of discipline identical to that imposed by the Court of Appeals of Maryland would be unwarranted. As of this date, Mr. Olszewski has not responded. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Kevin T. Olszewski is suspended indefinitely from the practice of law before the United States Court of Federal Claims pursuant to RCFC 83.2(c)(2) and (h)(4), effective on the date this Order is entered. *See* RCFC 83.2(c)(2), (h)(4). Reinstatement is not automatic. Petitions for reinstatement are governed by RCFC 83.2(k) and must be accompanied by a certificate of good standing from the bar of the highest court of a U.S. state or the District of Columbia. *See* RCFC 83.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall serve Kevin T. Olszewski with a copy of this order.
